What is Appreciative Inquiry?

- A methodology based on the belief that a positive vision of the future is based on a positive view of the past.
- Contrast with traditional problem solving approaches that seek to fix something that is "broken"
- Seeks to discovery what is unique about an organization via those extraordinary moments in the organization's past that describe the organization at it's best.
- Extraordinary moments are defined by people in the organization and why a given moment was so meaningful to them (representative s or sometimes the entire organization participates in the discussion).
- Themes are derived from the stories that identify the special qualities that make
 the organization the extraordinary place that it is. These themes are sometimes
 described as what produces the life-giving energy that must be preserved as the
 transformation proceeds.
- The themes are shared with the entire organization and serve to guide the change effort.
